October Curriculum

Reading/Language: During the month of October the students will be focusing on Journey's Informational Text. Also, Montessori provides the opportunity for students to work independently on SRA Reading Laboratory which includes: reading comprehension and word study.

Writing: Writing City Writing Curriculum- this month the students will be working on Narrative Essays.

Math: This month 4th graders will focus mainly on Multiplication and Division Word Problems following Singapore Math and giving the students the opportunity to explore and practice working on our Montessori lessons (Stamp Game, Checkerboard, and Pegboard). 5th graders will focus on multiplying and dividing whole numbers. In addition, they will add and subtract decimals.

Science: Physical and Chemical reactions, Experiments, Part of an Atom, Galaxies and Constellations are some topics that the students will be learning.

Social Studies: October will be a month where the students will explore and learn about Political and Physical Maps, Map of Florida (capital, mayor cities, and surrounding bodies of water). Also we are going to celebrate Hispanic Heritage.
