Our Lessons Continued

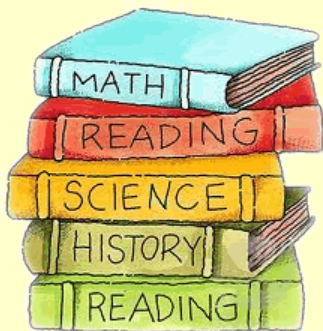
In **Biology**, we will be learning about the parts of a fruit, the biological evolution of life and we will begin to study the fish.

Our **Cosmic** curriculum will be focusing on how matter and energy came together to form stars, atoms, and galaxies. We will learning about constellations, planets and continue with the timeline of the Universe.

In **Language**, we will be working with types of verbs and learning their tenses, as well as how to form and use regular and irregular verbs. They will learning that words make phrases, phrases make sentences, and sentences make paragraphs.

In **Writing**, we will continue to use Writing City to teach writing strategies. Both second and third grade are working on Unit 2 Narrative Writing.

In **Mathematics**, the second graders will continue to work on addition and subtraction facts, above ten fact strategies, one-step word problems, odd and even numbers, Singapore Model Drawing, balance of expressions. The third graders will review addition and subtraction facts, above ten fact strategies, one-step word problems, odd and even numbers, Singapore Model Drawing, balance of expressions. They will begin working with addition and subtraction with three digits.
