Things to remember:

Writing

- First Graders are working on revising their writing with a partner, checking for grammatical errors, and spelling mistakes.
- Kindergarteners are working on using sight words in their writing and making sure there are spaces between their words.

Reading

- Kindergarteners and first graders are continuing to read books about Pumpkins, both fiction and nonfiction. They are discussing story elements and character traits.

Language

- Kindergarteners are working on phonemic awareness, letter sounds, family boxes, and using the movable alphabet. Many of them are starting to read using sight words, and the phonics knowledge they have gained.
- First Graders are working on the Waseca Towers, nouns, adjectives and rhyming words. They are beginning to label different parts of speech with the Montessori grammar symbols.

Mathematics

- Kindergarteners are continuing to work on number recognition and different ways to make 10, they have also covered 2D and 3D shapes.
- First Graders are continuing to work on fact families and geometry.

Social Studies: Kindergarteners and First Graders are continuing to discuss maps and geography.

Science: Kindergartners and First Graders are discussing weather, land, water, and seasons.
