November Curriculum

Reading/Language: During the month of November, the students will be focusing on Journeys Texts. Also, Montessori provides the opportunity for students to work independently on SRA Reading Laboratory which includes reading comprehension and word study. The focus for this month will be on Main Idea, Poetry and Compare & Contrast.

Writing: The Writing City Writing Curriculum for this month will include work on Informative/Explanatory Essays.

Math: This month 4th graders will focus mainly on Solving Multiple Steps Word Problems following Singapore Math and Multiplying and Dividing Whole Numbers. 5th graders will focus on Adding and Subtracting Fractions and Word Problem.

Science: Spheres of the Earth, Earth Science, Oceans, Waterways, the Water Cycle, and Type of Rocks are some topics that the students will be learning.

Social Studies: November will be a month where 4th grade students will explore and learn about Florida Maps, Hurricane Preparedness in Florida, and Government Branches. 5th Graders will study US Destinations, American Indians, and Early Explorers.
