Reading/Language Arts

For the month of April, the students will mostly be reviewing all that they have learned over the school year. They will utilize reading units, 4th grade will use Pushing Up the Sky, while 5th graders will use The Lion, the, Witch, and the Wardrobe to deepen their reading skills.

They will continue to use Montessori grammar boxes to learn prepositions, interjections, and to review all language skills they have learned previously.

Writing

Although the students will take their FSA writing in the first week of April, they will continue to use the Writing City resource to continue applying the writing skills that they learned. Additionally, they will learn how to research and write reports on a variety of topics.

Math

Fourth-grade will be introduced to Measure and Draw Angles, Add and Subtract with Angles, Points, Lines, Rays, and Angles. The students will also learn to Classify Shapes and Angles.

Fifth-graders will continue learning strategies that will help them to Graph Points in the Coordinate Plane, Classify Two-Dimensional Figures, and Understand Properties of Two-Dimensional Figures.
