This Month...

In Reading, students will continue using metacognitive strategies like asking questions, making predictions, and summarizing to improve comprehension. They'll also work with Waseca Towers to build vocabulary, sentence structure, and pronunciation through suffixes, schwa sounds, and silent letters

In Writing, students will learn to create multimedia presentations, focusing on planning, organizing, and using visuals, audio, and text effectively.

Mathematics:

Students will start with a unit review, then explore graphs, perimeter, and lines of symmetry in 2D and 3D shapes.

Science: In Science, students will continue learning about life cycles and will also explore the human body, focusing on its systems and how they work together.
